



ROSSI CONTINUES 3RD PLACE PODIUM STREAK IN CATALUNYA!

Movistar® Yamaha MotoGP®'s Valentino Rossi took his third consecutive 3rd place finish in the 2018 MotoGP® World Championship in Sunday's Gran Premi Monster Energy® de Catalunya. Teammate Maverick Viñales endured a tough start at the Circuit de Barcelona-Catalunya. He placed mid-pack after the start but made up positions in the second half of the race to take 6th place crossing the finish line. Valentino Rossi and Maverick Viñales also retained their 2nd and 3rd place standings respectively in the 2018 MotoGP® World Championship rankings.



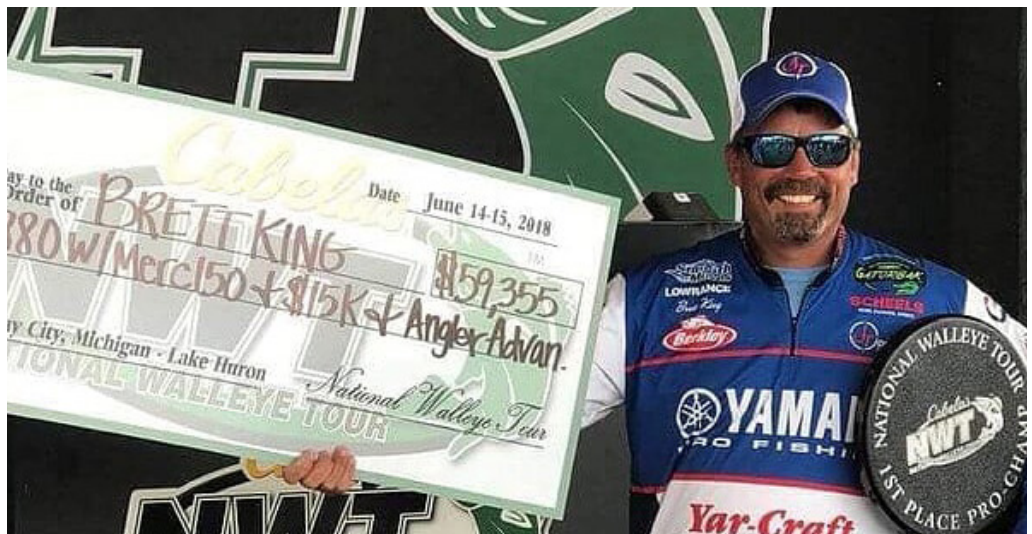
CHAD WIENE CLAIMS 2ND PLACE AT SUNSET RIDGE ATV MX NATIONAL
