



DYLAN FERRANDIS CLAIMS OVERALL VICTORY IN 250 CLASS AT UNADILLA MX NATIONAL AND JUSTIN BARCIA AND AARON PLESSINGER SELECTED TO REPRESENT THE U.S. AT 2018 FIM MOTOCROSS OF NATIONS!

Monster Energy®/Yamalube®/Star Racing's Dylan Ferrandis claimed his second career overall victory with 1-1 finishes at this weekend's AMA National MX race at the iconic Unadilla track in upstate New Berlin New York with typical chaotically muddy conditions while his team mate and current points leader Aaron Plessinger finished second overall with 2-2 finishes. Plessinger now leads the series by 78 points over the second-place rider. Justin Barcia once again put in another solid ride aboard his Monster Energy®/Yamaha Factory YZ450F with 8-3 finishes and continues to hold down third in the series.



Additionally, the American Motorcyclist Association® (AMA) announced the U.S. team lineup for the 2018 FIM Motocross of Nations (MXoN) prior to the start of this weekend's Motocross National in New Berlin, New York. The three-rider lineup includes Yamaha bLU cRU riders Justin Barcia and Aaron Plessinger, along with American teammate Eli Tomac. The event takes place October 6 and 7 on their home soil at the iconic RedBud MX facility in Buchanan, Michigan.



ROSSI RIDES STRONG COMEBACK RACE TO SIXTH AT THE RED BULL RING

Movistar Yamaha MotoGP's Valentino Rossi saved the best for last during a difficult weekend at the Red Bull Ring – Spielberg track. He picked up the pace at the Motorrad Grand Prix von Österreich on race day and rode from 14th on the grid to a solid 6th position at the finish. Maverick Viñales had a difficult start from 11th, but once he got going he set multiple red sectors to climb back up the order and secure 12th place.



CHAD WIENER CLAIMS HIS 6TH ATV MX NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP ON HIS YFZ 450R!

Wiener Motorsports/Yamaha/Maxxis' Chad Wiener came into the final round at this weekend's 33rd Annual ATV Motocross National Championship (ATVMX) in Hurricane Mills Tennessee a stout 10 points behind in the championship battle. Chad claimed the overall victory this weekend on his YFZ 450R and his 6th National Championship!



CAMERON BEAUBIER AND JD BEACH EACH CLAIM DOUBLE VICTORIES IN MOTOAMERICA ROUND AT SONOMA RACEWAY!

Monster Energy®/Yamalube/Yamaha Factory Racing's Cameron Beaubier extended his MotoAmerica® Superbike championship lead once again to 63 points with back-to-back wins on his YZF-R1 Superbike this weekend at Sonoma Raceway while Monster Energy®/Y.E.S./Graves rider JD Beach also claimed wins on each day on his YZF-R6 in the Supersport class and extended his lead in the championship to 100 points! Josh Herrin finished 2nd in the Superbike class on Saturday and 3rd on Sunday while Hayden Gillim finished 3rd in the Supersport class on Saturday and Sunday. In Junior Cup action on Saturday, YZF-R3® riders Jay Newton finished 2nd and Jackson Blackmon 3rd while on Sunday Cory Ventura was credited with a win following a red flag that ultimately halted the race.
