



## DRAMATIC END TO MOVISTAR YAMAHA'S RUN AT DRENCHED VALENCIA MOTOGP® FINALE

The Movistar Yamaha MotoGP® Team were unlucky to see both their riders crash out of promising positions at this past weekend's Gran Premio Motul de la Comunitat Valenciana, after the brave efforts of Valentino Rossi and Maverick Viñales in torrential rain. Rossi gave an incredibly impressive performance riding from 16th to 3rd place in the first race, which was red flagged after 13 laps. During the re-start he was set to take 2nd position until a crash at Turn 12 meant the end of his challenge. Earlier on in the first race, pole-setter Viñales also suffered an unfortunate premature halt to his strong pursuit of a podium finish. As his crash happened on lap 12, and the shortened second race's grid positions were based on the standings at the start of lap 13, he was unable to join the rematch.



## YAMAHA POWERED TEAM CROWNED KINGS

Captain Charles Cherko, Team Reelentless, was crowned KING at the 25th Annual 2018 Old Salt Fall King of the Beach, taking home \$94,920, weighing in at 46.82 lb. kingfish.
