With some luck and a very solid race, Johann Zarco claimed his second podium in 2018, and the Monster® Yamaha Tech3 star, who concluded the fourth race of the season as the best Yamaha rider of the field, also took over the 2nd spot in the World Championship.

Meanwhile, Movistar Yamaha MotoGP®'s Valentino Rossi and Maverick Viñales' persistence earned them valuable points for the championship too. They pushed to the fullest at a hot and slippery Circuito de Jerez - Ángel Nieto, securing 5th and 7th place respectively.
